Students are responsible for reviewing their Degree Works in MyCollege to verify graduation requirements. Run and review your Degree Works at least once a semester. If you have questions, contact your CJES advisor.

CRJ Electives: Recommend CRJ 201, 204, 206, 218, 260, or any CRJ course not required in program. Or, choose any Fire Science (FRS) or Homeland Security (HLS) course or EMT 110 Basic Emergency Medical Technician (8 credits – counts for 2 CRJ electives).

For additional acceptable electives and/or special offerings, contact your CJES advisor.

ENG 110 or 110S: based on placement. Students who test into ENG 110S should take in place of ENG 110.

Math: MAT 124 Statistics I is recommended for seamless transfer to a CJ Bachelor's program.

Natural Lab Science: Recommend CHM 121, CHM 125, EAS 123, ANT 113, BIO 155, CHM 290, or choose any Gen Ed approved course (4 credits) by searching the Gen Ed Natural Sciences **Attribute Type** on course schedule search.

Technology Elective: BIT207 recommended or any other Business Information Technology (BIT) course for a total of 3 credits.

Humanities, Arts, Foreign Language: Choose any Gen Ed approved course in these areas by selecting the appropriate **Attribute Type** (Gen Ed Foreign Language, Gen Ed The Arts, or Gen Ed Humanities) on course schedule search.

Social Science: Recommend SOC 110 (in addition to PSY 110), PSY 255*, BUS 215, or any approved social science elective, or choose from the Gen Ed Social Science Attribute Type on course schedule search.


*PSY 110 is a pre-req for PSY 255. Must obtain permission from Chair of Psychology Department to use SOC 110 as pre-req for PSY 255.

Students who prefer a fulltime schedule of 4 courses (12 credits) each semester, should consider taking courses during the summer and winter semesters to complete the program in 2 years.

1. Log into MyCollege

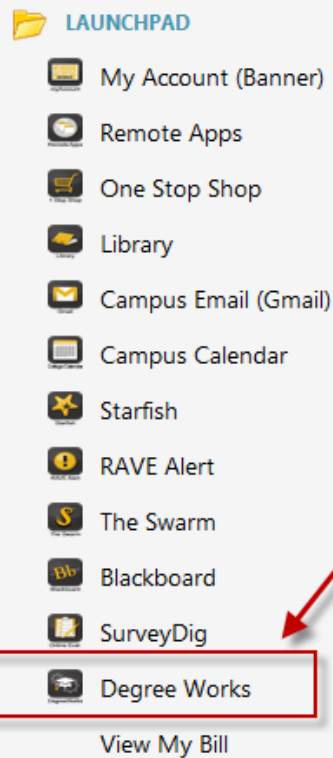


