The purpose of this articulation agreement is to recognize achievement and provide advanced standing to graduates of the DCMO BOCES Security & Law Enforcement (Criminal Justice) Program in the A.A.S Criminal Justice - Police (CJPO) or A.S. Criminal Justice - Corrections (CJCO) or A.S. Homeland Security (HMSC) program at SUNY Broome Community College.


Advanced placement with college credit will be granted for graduates of the DCMO BOCES Security & Law Enforcement Program who meet the criteria listed below and are admitted into the SUNY Broome CJPO or CJCO or HMSC program. Students interested in attending SUNY Broome shall participate in the normal admissions, placement testing, and advisement processes at the College.


The criteria and process for granting credit at SUNY Broome Community College is as follows:


1. The student must have completed the program(s) specified in this agreement with a grade of "80%" or better.
 - a. Students will receive 3 credits for CRJ 111 Introduction to Criminal Justice for the completion of the 1st year of the DCMO BOCES Security & Law Enforcement program.
 - b. Students will receive 3 credits for CRJ 255 Special Topics in Criminal Justice for the second year of completion of the DCMO BOCES Security & Law Enforcement program.
 - c. Students will receive 3 credits for CRJ999 CRJ Elective for passing the NOCTI Exam with a score of 80% or higher. *This applies only to CJPO & CJCO majors – this does not apply to HMSC majors.
2. The student must meet the performance outcomes and competencies specified in the course outlines.
