## Not allowed in Resident Suite

**Extension cords**

**Multi-plug / Tri-tap adapters**

**Halogen lamps, black lights, lava lamps or other high intensity lamps including torchier lamps, spider lamps, or upward facing bowl lamps**

**Coffee makers**

**Toaster ovens / hot plates**

**Foreman or similar grills**

**Electric Fry pans**

**Waffle, sandwich, quesadilla makers**

**Oil fyers**

**Auxillary heaters**

**Refrigerators exceeding 4.0cu/ft**

**Air conditioners**

**\*\*\* Non fire treated curtains/ flags / and tapestries**

## Allowed in Resident Suite

**\*\*All electronics and appliances must be UL approved**

**\*\* All electrical devices must be plugged directly in to a wall outlet or approved power strip**

**Power strip with circuit breaker**

**Keurig style coffee maker**

**Computer**

**TV / DVD / video gaming system**

**Battery operated candles**

**Fire treated curtains/ flags / tapestry  
\*\*must have tags and documentation  
meeting NFPA 701**
