*Writing Intensive Course

- 1 JUST 429 is a prerequisite for JUST 430 only
- 2 Program electives are JUST or LEST courses. Others may be included with approval of the Department Chair
- 3 Students must complete 7 out of 10 GER areas, and have at least 30 total GER credits
- 4 Baccalaureate degrees require successful completion of the prescribed curriculum, composed of 45 upper division credit hours, 24 of which must be taken within the major. Students may need to complete 3 additional upper division credit hours of general electives to meet this requirement.


STUDENT ELIGIBILITY: Graduates of Associate of Science– Homeland Security program at SUNY Broome must possess a **minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale**. SUNY Canton **assures acceptance for SUNY Broome students who have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better**. Students are encouraged to apply during their last semester at SUNY Broome .


