

**TRANSFER AGREEMENT IN MUSIC EDUCATION BETWEEN  
HARTWICK COLLEGE  
AND  
SUNY BROOME COMMUNITY COLLEGE**



This document describes an agreement between Hartwick College, Oneonta, New York, and SUNY Broome Community College, Binghamton, New York, to facilitate transfer for students from SUNY Broome Community College who wish to earn baccalaureate degrees in Music Education at Hartwick College.


1. Students who have successfully completed an Associate of Science in Music degree with music electives in music education/performance at SUNY Broome Community College with a cumulative average of 2.75 or higher, have successfully completed at least seven of the ten SUNY General Education Requirements, have met the usual criteria for admission to Hartwick College and the Department of Music, and passed the music audition are guaranteed admission with first-term junior standing (60 credits minimum) to the Department of Music at Hartwick College. To earn a Hartwick Baccalaureate degree (120 credits), they must:
  - a. Complete at least 45 credits at Hartwick with a cumulative average of 2.00 or higher.
  - b. Take the writing placement examination. Depending on the result, additional course work in writing may be necessary to attain the level required for graduation.
  - c. Complete the requirements for the Music Education degree with a cumulative average of 3.0 or higher.
  - d. Music Education majors who transfer courses completed with less than a C will have to retake those courses and earn a grade of at least a C to be recommended for certification
  - e. Complete WICK-101, Hartwick's transfer student orientation course in the first term.
2. Students from SUNY Broome Community College who transfer to Hartwick without the A.S. degree must meet the usual conditions for admission to Hartwick College. Courses with grades of 'C' or higher will be evaluated on a course-by-course basis.
3. Hartwick College agrees to inform SUNY Broome Community College of any future changes in these requirements and to provide a reasonable schedule for implementation of such changes.
4. Both Hartwick College and SUNY Broome Community College agree to encourage qualified students to participate in this arrangement and to provide students with appropriate information, advising and assistance.
5. Representatives from both institutions will confer from time to time and at least biannually to monitor the use of this agreement and consider any changes that affect the agreement and possible improvements to the agreement.
6. This agreement may be revised or cancelled by mutual agreement between the two institutions. It may be revised or cancelled by either party at the end of any academic year,


provided that written notice is submitted to the other party at least twelve months before the effective date.
