ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

This agreement establishes an Articulation Agreement between SUNY Broome and St. John Fisher College. Students selected for matriculation in this program will, upon completion of a prescribed sequence of courses leading to an associate degree from SUNY Broome, continue their studies at St. John Fisher College with assurance that they may complete the 60 semester credit hours in conformity with the academic standards of St. John Fisher College and as prescribed in the appropriate Degree Guidesheets (certain majors may require the completion of more than two-years of full-time study).

STUDENT SELECTION

SUNY Broome will be responsible for the selection of candidates for admission to the articulation program. In general, applicants will be expected to present strong records of academic achievement including four years of English, three years of social studies, and mathematics, and at least two years of study in science. In addition, SUNY Broome will designate appropriate prerequisites for matriculation in any of the curricula included in the articulation program.

GPA REQUIREMENTS

In no instance shall a student graduating with an associate degree from SUNY Broome be expected to meet St. John Fisher College higher GPA standards than a St. John Fisher College student entering the junior year. St. John Fisher College policies and procedures as to academic standing, however, shall apply. Students interested in all majors included in the articulation program must present a minimum GPA of 2.0. Some degree programs may require higher GPA's and/or pre-requisite coursework to continue at St. John Fisher College. Please refer to appropriate Degree Guidesheets.

In the case of other baccalaureate programs which are not covered by the articulation agreement or in the case when a student changes from his/her originally intended 2+2 major, SUNY Broome students shall follow normal procedures for transfer admission. Students will be subject

to the same requirements for these programs as other students applying, including those having completed lower-division work at St. John Fisher College.

STUDENT ACADEMIC ADVISEMENT

SUNY Broome staff will assume responsibility for advising students who enroll in the articulation admission program. Curriculum guidesheets will be used as the mechanism for communicating degree requirements to students. Guidesheets will be reviewed periodically and appropriate revisions to guidesheets will be made as each institution adds, deletes, or changes course offerings.

When appropriate, staff members from St. John Fisher College will offer special orientation/advisement sessions for students in the articulation program at SUNY Broome. When appropriate, St. John Fisher College agrees to meet with faculty and staff at SUNY Broome who will be involved in consulting with and advising students enrolled in the articulation program.

Staff members from SUNY Broome and the Transfer Admissions Office at St. John Fisher College will be designated as contact persons and coordinators of this articulation program agreement.

ARTICULATION PROCEDURES

Participants are required to submit a separate SJFC Transfer Application (available on-line at www.sjfc.edu/transfer) the semester before intended enrollment at St. John Fisher College. SJFC will automatically send participants information regarding the submission of the Transfer Application and provide an application fee waiver code.

Students who wish to change their majors upon enrolling at St. John Fisher College will be permitted to do so and may still be able to earn their baccalaureate degrees with the completion of 60 additional credit hours. In cases such as majors in disciplines which are sequential, or which require a large number of sequence courses and professional programs which are highly structured, pursuit of a different baccalaureate degree at St. John Fisher College may require the completion of more than 60 credit hours.

Each semester, SUNY Broome will provide acceptance lists and transcripts of students enrolled in 2+2 programs. This will allow St. John Fisher College to monitor the flow of students through the program. Biographic and academic data on each student will be provided to the Transfer Admissions Office at St. John Fisher College so that literature and other relevant programmatic information can be sent to students during the time that they are pursuing their studies at SUNY Broome.

TIME FRAME AND PROVISION FOR PROGRAM REVIEW

All students currently enrolled at SUNY Broome and those admitted to begin their studies at SUNY Broome in Fall 2017 through Spring 2018, are eligible to be considered for this articulation program.
