- Natural Lab Science – must be a four-credit science with a lab. Choose from the Natural Sciences category of the General Education Chart/Degree Works Audit.
- Advisor Approved English Course – Choose ENG111 or higher. English Language Learners will take ENG108.
- Any and all substitutions need to be approved in writing (appear on your Degree Evaluation) in advance by the Business Department Chair.
