- ENG110 or ENG107 – English Language Learners will take ENG107 instead of ENG110. ENG 091 co-requisite with ENG 110 may be required based on placement assessment. Consult with your advisor for appropriate placement.
- Business Electives – choose any BUS course not required in program. Consult with advisor for best choices related to career interests.
- Lab Science – recommend any four-credit natural lab science for best transfer. Recommend PHS111, PHS112, PHS113, PHS114, PHS115, PHS116, CHM121, CHM123, ANT112, ANT113.
- Advisor Approved General Education – choose any General Education approved course. ECO 110 and BUS 115 do not satisfy this requirement as they are already program requirements.
- BIT Elective – choose any BIT course (either 3 credits or three 1 credit BIT courses).
- BUS115 Business Statistics – recommend two years of high school math that includes elementary algebra. Consult with advisor if questions.
- Social Science Elective – choose any General Education approved course in the social sciences category. ECO 110 does not satisfy this elective requirement.
- English/Literature Course – choose any ENG111 or higher level ENG course or any Literature (LIT) course. Recommend LIT course for best transfer. English Language Learners will take ENG108.
- Any and all substitutions need to be approved in writing (appear on your Degree Evaluation) in advance by the Chair or Coordinator of Program.
