ENG 110 or 111: based on placement.

Physical Ed: PED 118 and 119 required.

History: Any Gen Ed US History, Other World Civilization, or Western Civilization approved "HIS" course.

Natural Lab Science: Recommend CHM 121, EAS 123, ANT 113, or choose any Gen Ed Natural Sciences approved course (4 credits).

Technology Elective: BIT 207 recommended or any other Business Information Technology (BIT) course for a total of 3 credits.

CRJ Elective: Recommend CRJ 206, CRJ 204, CRJ 201, or any CRJ course not required in program. CRJ 246 can be used as elective or Social Science (not both). Or, choose any Homeland Security (HLS), or any Fire Science (FRS) course, or EMT 110 Basic Emergency Medical Technician (8 credits – counts for 1 CRJ elective). For additional acceptable electives and/or special offerings, contact your CJES advisor.

Math: Choose any "MAT" Gen Ed Mathematics approved course (BUS 115 **not** accepted in this program). **MAT 124** Statistics I is recommended for seamless transfer to a CJ Bachelor's program.

Social Science: Recommend CRJ 246 (if not taken as CRJ elective), PSY 255*, BUS 215, SOC 110 (in addition to PSY 110), or choose any Gen Ed Social Science approved course, or social science elective.


*PSY 110 is a pre-req for PSY 255. Must obtain permission from Chair of Psychology Department to use SOC 110 as pre-req for PSY 255 if PSY 110 not already completed.

Students who prefer less than the recommended courses each semester will need to consider taking courses during the summer and winter semesters in order to complete the program in 2 years.

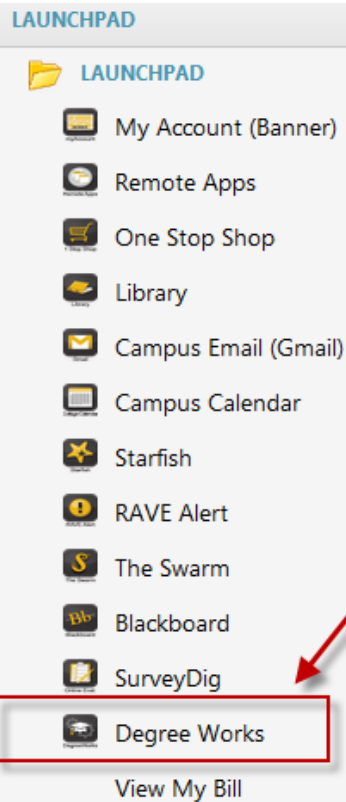


