



## **Unofficial or Rejected FAFSA**

The results of your FAFSA indicate that your application was missing required data or contains inconsistent information. As a result, your application is unofficial, and SUNY Broome cannot continue processing your financial aid request.

In order to fix your Rejected FAFSA you must do the following:

- 1) Read the comments on your processed FAFSA or Student Aid Report (SAR) to determine what is missing or is inconsistent, and correct the information as necessary. You can review your comments at <a href="http://www.fafsa.gov">http://www.fafsa.gov</a>.
- 2) Once you have determined what needs to be corrected, go back on the FAFSA website at <a href="http://www.fafsa.gov">http://www.fafsa.gov</a>, log in to your FAFSA, and make the corrections as necessary. You may use the table below to find the error that corresponds with the comment on your FAFSA and the instructions for correcting that error.
- 3) Sign your corrections with your FSA ID and your parent's FSA ID (if you are a dependent student).
