

Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)

Food insecurity and hunger can affect anyone.

Under federal law, if you are a college student between the ages of 18 and 49 years old and you are attending an institution of higher education (like SUNY Broome!) at least half-time, you **MAY** be eligible to receive food assistance through SNAP benefits, if you meet certain criteria.

SUNY Broome cannot determine whether you are eligible for SNAP. That determination is made by each County's local Department of Social Services. To check your eligibility, go to mybenefits.ny.gov. Additional assistance can be found at foodhelpny.org.

One of the eligibility criteria is that you are currently enrolled at least half-time in a Career and Technical Education program that falls within HEGIS codes 5000-5599. At SUNY Broome, these programs include:

A **SNAP Student Enrollment Verification Form** (LDSS-5172) must be submitted when you apply for SNAP to verify that you are enrolled at least half-time in a Career and Technical Education program, and therefore satisfy the requirements of this criteria.

When you receive the completed Form from the Registrar's office, be sure to submit it when you complete your SNAP application at mybenefits.ny.gov.
