## Accreditation Actions

**June 24, 2021**

To acknowledge receipt of the self-study report. To note that the institution hosted a virtual site visit in lieu of an on-site visit in accordance with the United States Department of Education (USDE) guidelines published March 17, 2020. To reaffirm accreditation. To request that beginning in 2022 and in conjunction with each Annual Institutional Update prior to the Mid-Point Peer Review in 2025, the institution provide further evidence of a clearly articulated and transparent governance structure that outlines roles, responsibilities, and accountability for decision-making by each constituency (Standard VII). To note that a verification visit is required by USDE guidelines and will be conducted within a reasonable period of time following the virtual site visit. The next evaluation visit is scheduled for 2028-2029.

**June 27, 2019**

To note the visit by the Commission's representative and to affirm the inclusion of the additional locations at (1) Binghamton High School, 31 Main Street, Binghamton, NY 13905; (2) Maine-Endwell High School, 750 Farm to Market Road, Endwell, NY 13760; and (3) Windsor High School, 1191 NY-79, Windsor, NY 13865, within the scope of the institution's accreditation. The next evaluation visit is scheduled for 2020-2021.

**March 4, 2019**

To acknowledge receipt of the substantive change request. To include the additional location at SUNY Broome Culinary and Event Center, 78 Exchange Street, Binghamton, NY 13901 within the institution's scope of accreditation. To note that a substantive change site visit is not required. To require immediate notification when instruction commences at each location. To note that the Commission may rescind this action if instruction does not commence within one calendar year from the date of this action. The next evaluation visit is scheduled for 2020-2021.

**August 27, 2018**

To acknowledge receipt of the substantive change request. **November 16, 2017**

To accept the progress report. The next evaluation visit is now scheduled for 2020-2021.

**November 17, 2016**

To accept the Periodic Review Report and to reaffirm accreditation. To request a progress report, due October 1, 2017, further documenting (1) development and implementation of a comprehensive institutional strategic plan that links long-range planning to decision making and budgeting processes (Standard 2); (2) steps taken to improve the college catalog including clearly articulated statements of student learning outcomes for all degree and certificate programs (Standard 6); and, (3) implementation of the revised general education curriculum and implementation of an assessment process for general education (Standard 12). The next evaluation visit is scheduled for 2020-2021.

**March 3, 2016**

To accept the supplemental information report. The Periodic Review Report is due June 1, 2016

**October 28, 2015**

To request a supplemental information report, due January 4, 2016, addressing the recent action by the Joint Review Committee on Education in Radiologic Technology (JRCERT).

**November 15, 2012**

To accept the monitoring report. The Periodic Review Report is due June 1, 2016.

**March 1, 2012**

To accept the progress report. To remind the institution of the monitoring report, due September 1, 2012, documenting evidence of (1) periodic assessment of the Board of Trustees in meeting its own stated objectives, of the effectiveness of institutional leadership and governance, and of the effectiveness of the shared governance structure (Standard 4); (2) continued progress in the implementation of institutional assessment; and (3) the use assessment results, including results of student learning assessment, to inform institutional planning and resource allocation (Standard 7). The Periodic Review Report is due June 1, 2016.

## Information about the Middle States Commission on Higher Education

*The Middle States Commission on Higher Education (MSCHE) is one of seven institutional accrediting organizations in the United States and is recognized by the U.S. Secretary of Education and the Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA). MSCHE accreditation applies to an institution as a whole rather than the specific programs within an institution. MSCHE does not approve or accredit individual programs. The MSCHE accreditation review cycle is continuous and accreditation does not expire. Each institution is reevaluated and monitored on a regular and consistent basis in accordance with the institution's assigned accreditation review cycle and Commission policy and procedures. An institution maintains its accreditation unless it is voluntarily surrendered or withdrawn by the Commission for cause, after the institution has been afforded due process.
