







Fall 2021 Enrollment by Degree Type





#### Fall 2021 Enrollment by Academic Division





Fall 2021 Enrollment by Age





Fall 2021 Enrollment by Gender





## Fall 2021 Enrollment by Race/Ethnicity





Fall 2021 Enrollment by Residence




