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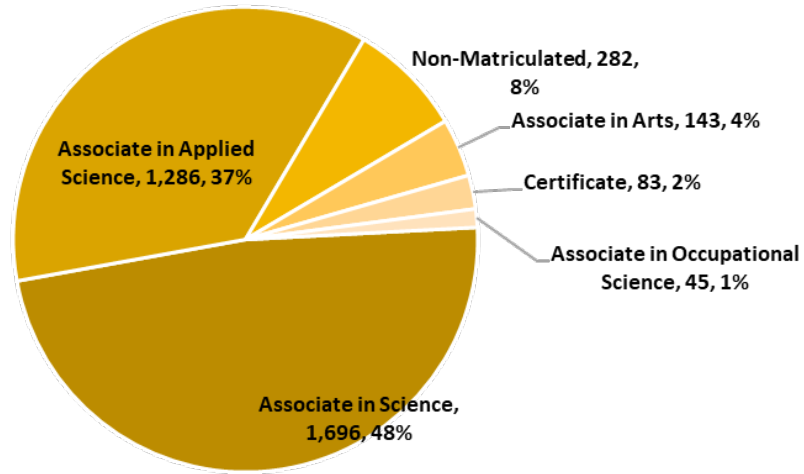

Fall 2022 Enrollment by Degree Type

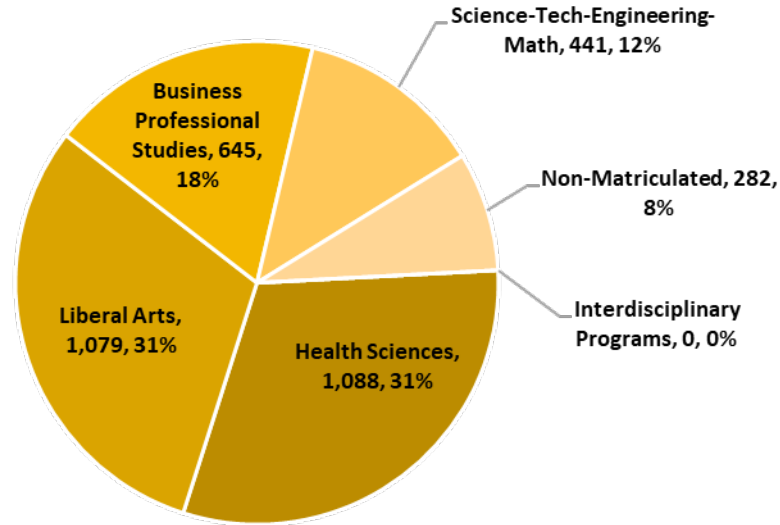
Fall 2022 Enrollment by Degree Type (Excluding Fast Forward)

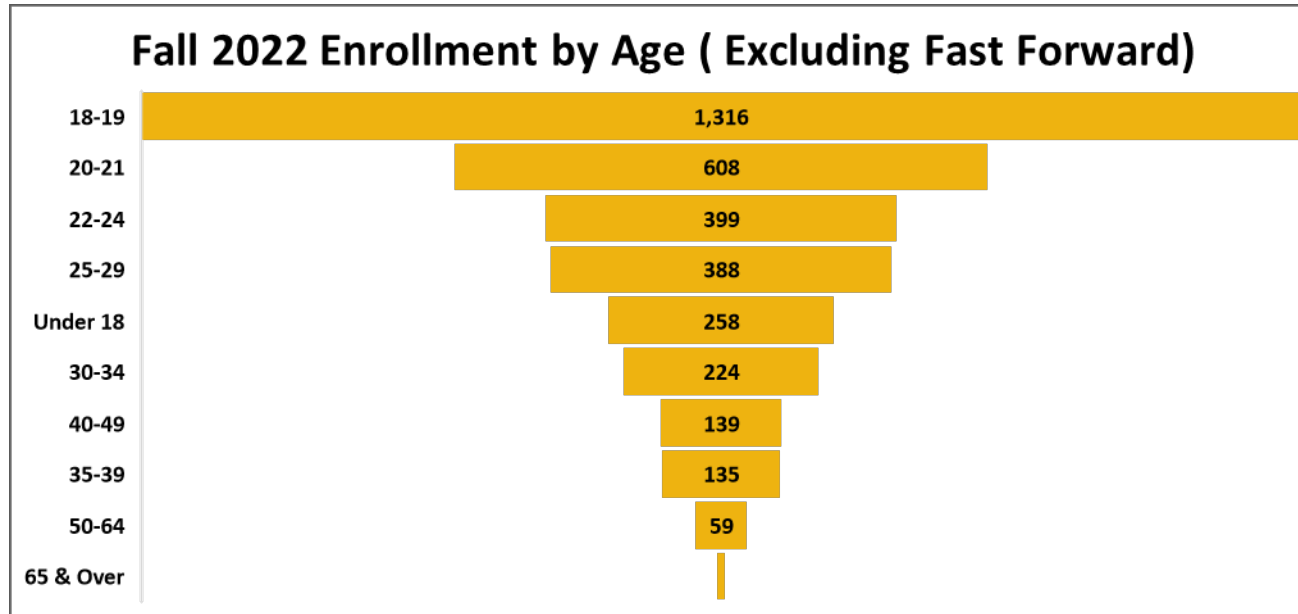
Fall 2022 Enrollment by Academic Division

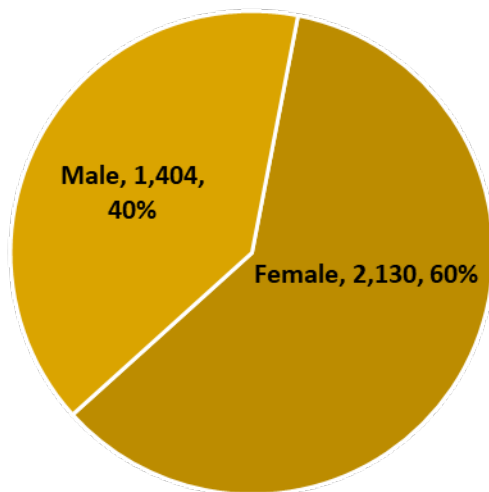
Fall 2022 Enrollment by Age

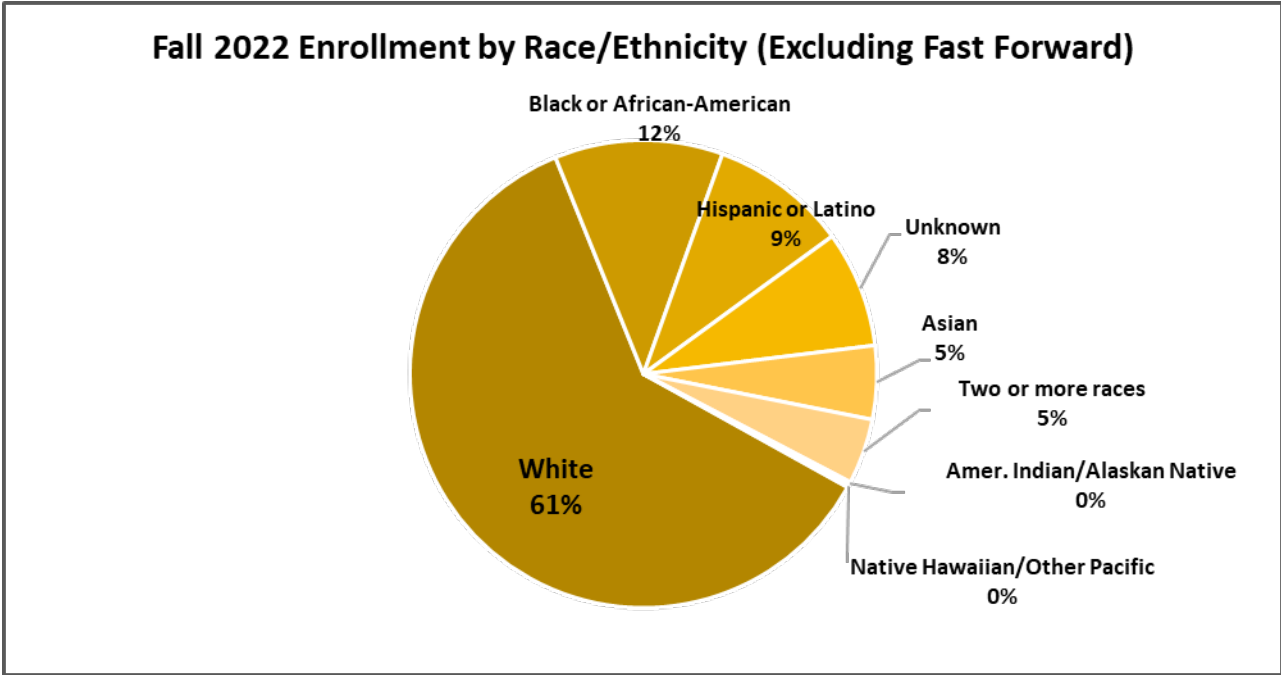
Fall 2022 Enrollment by Gender

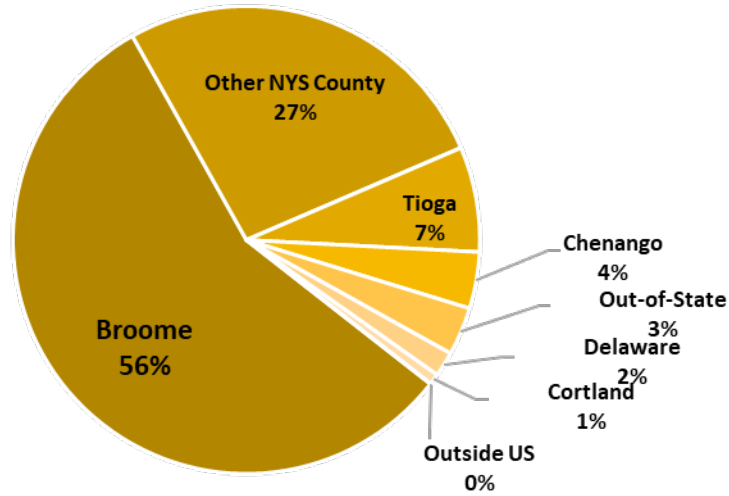
Fall 2022 Enrollment by Race/Ethnicity

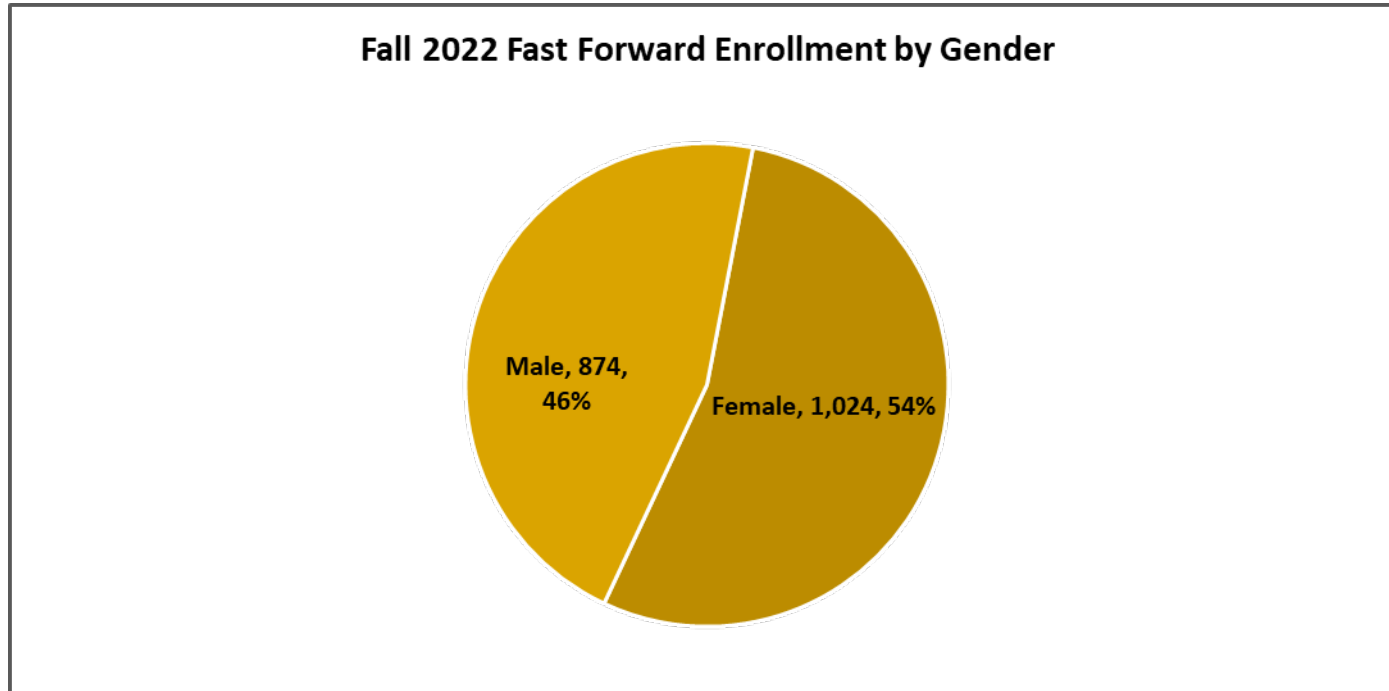
Fall 2022 Enrollment by Residence

Fall 2022 Enrollment by Residency (Excluding Fast Forward)



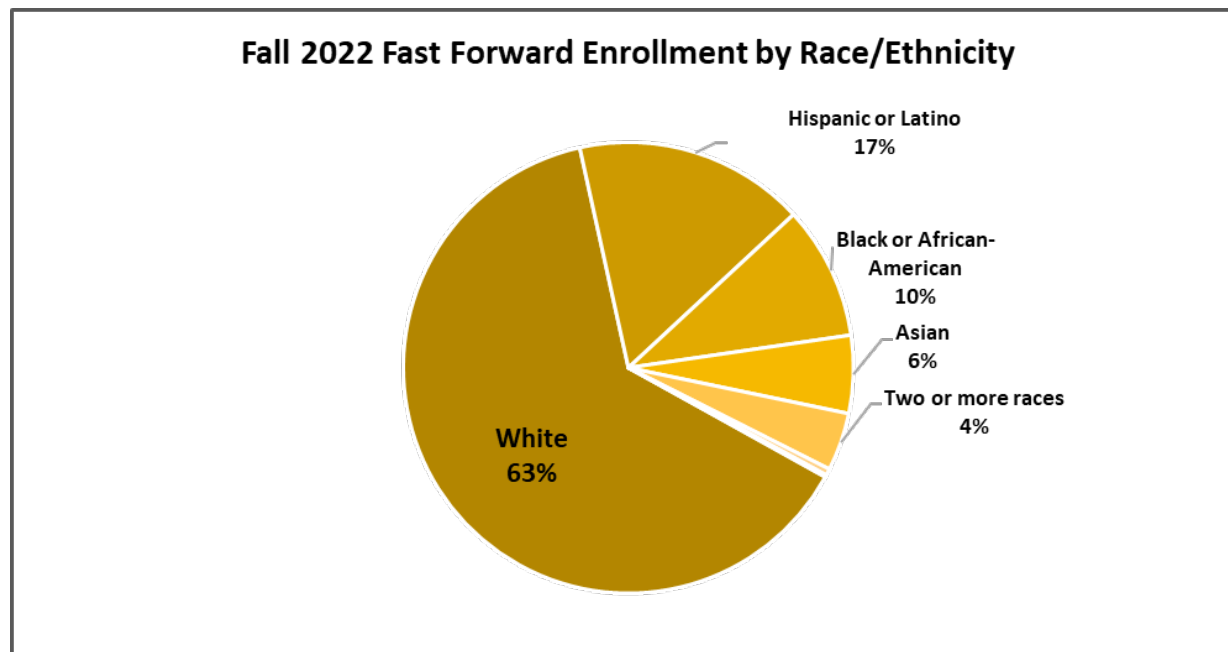
