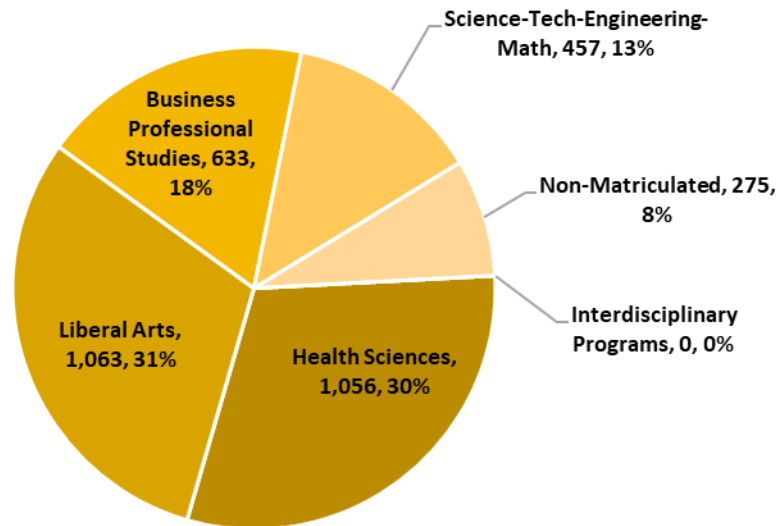

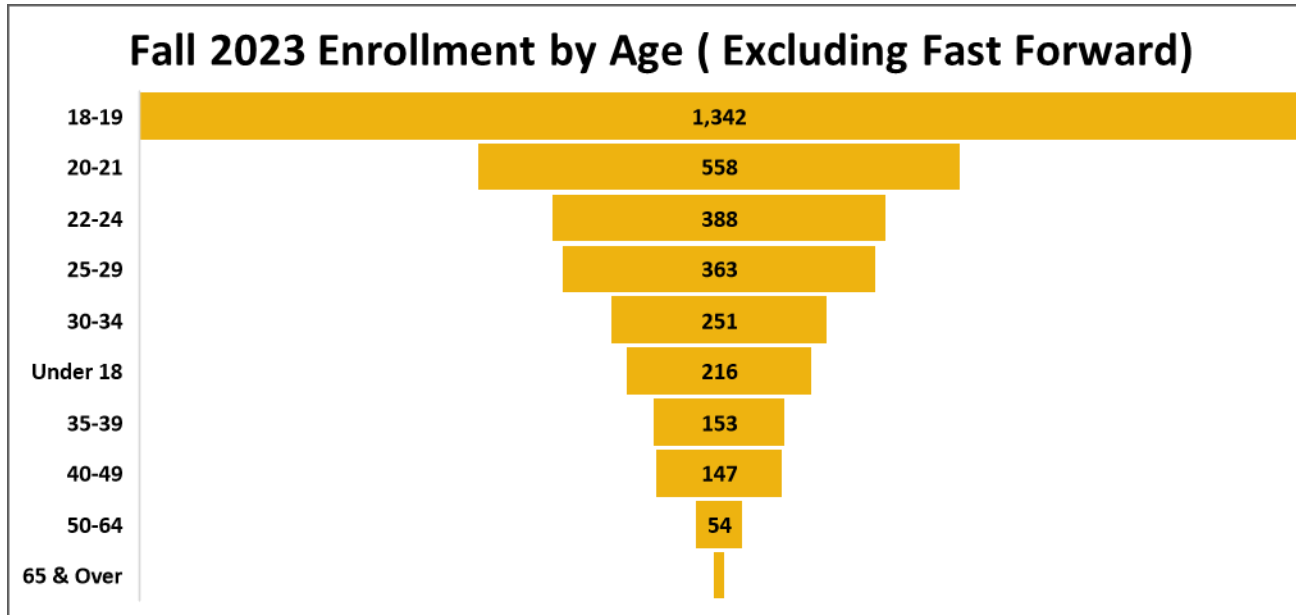

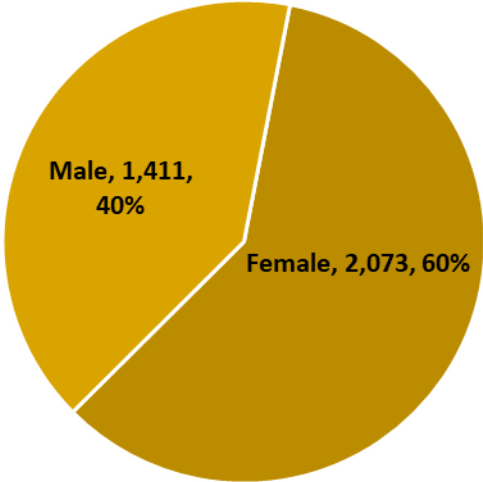

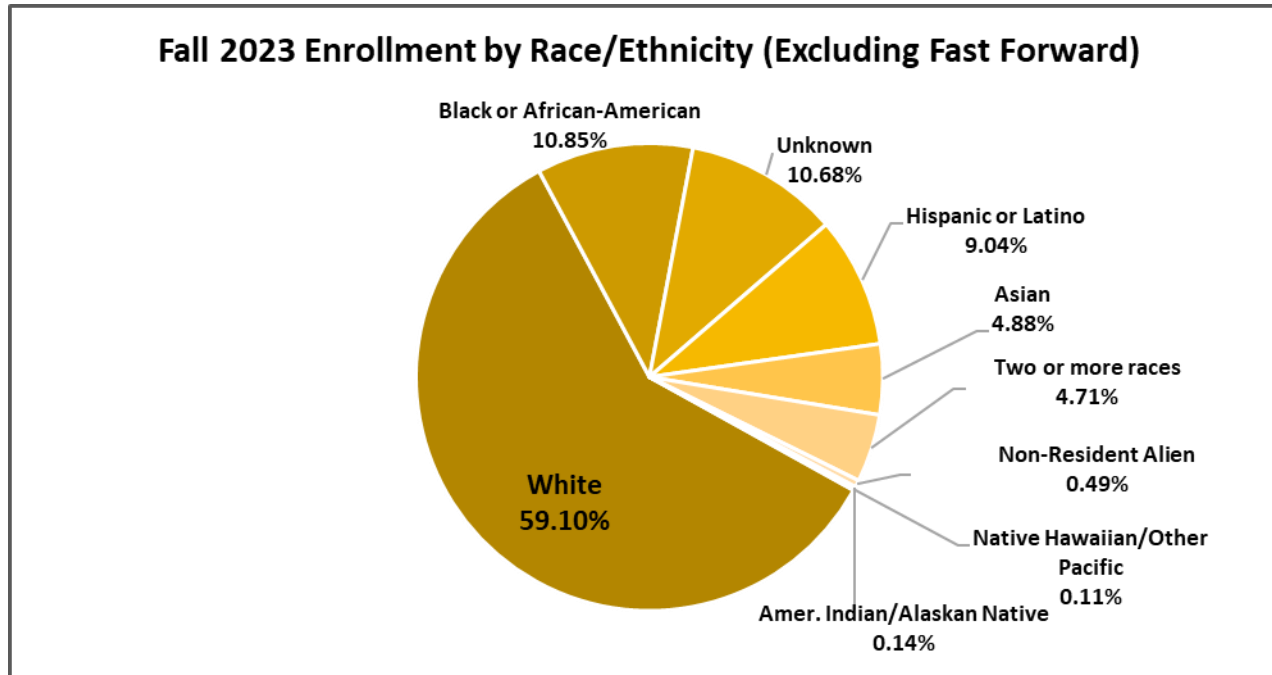
## Fall 2023 Enrollment by Gender (Excluding Fast Forward)

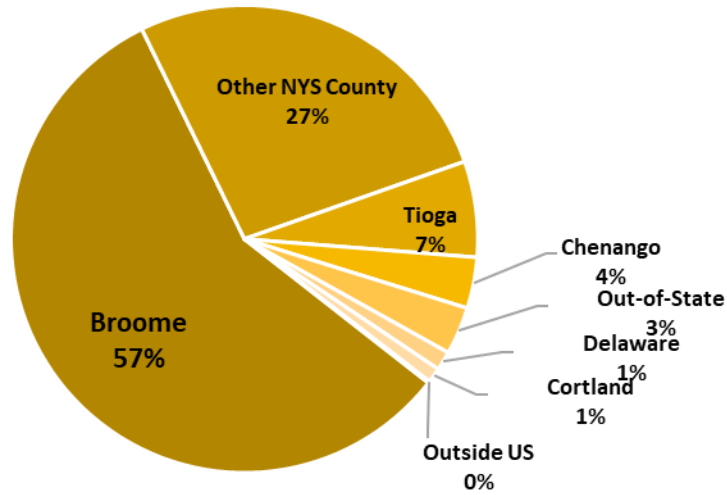

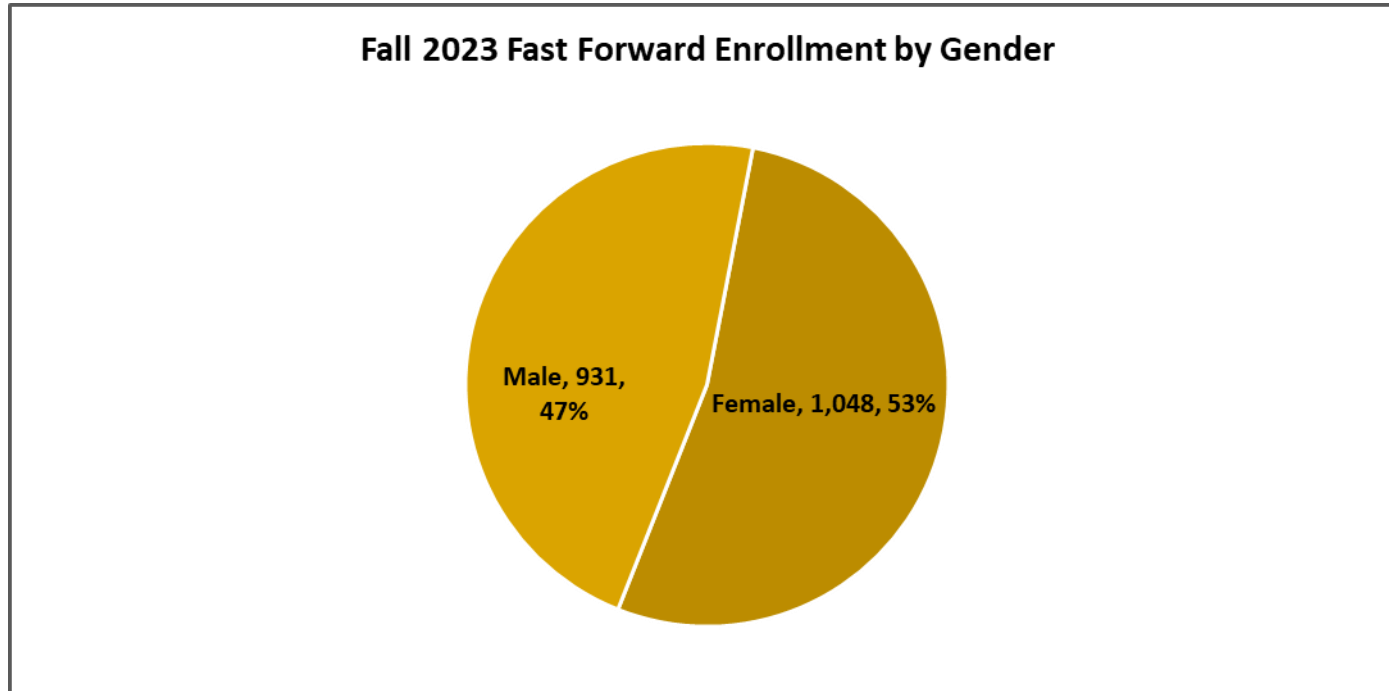
## Fall 2023 Enrollment by Residence

**Fall 2023 Enrollment by Residency (Excluding Fast Forward)**



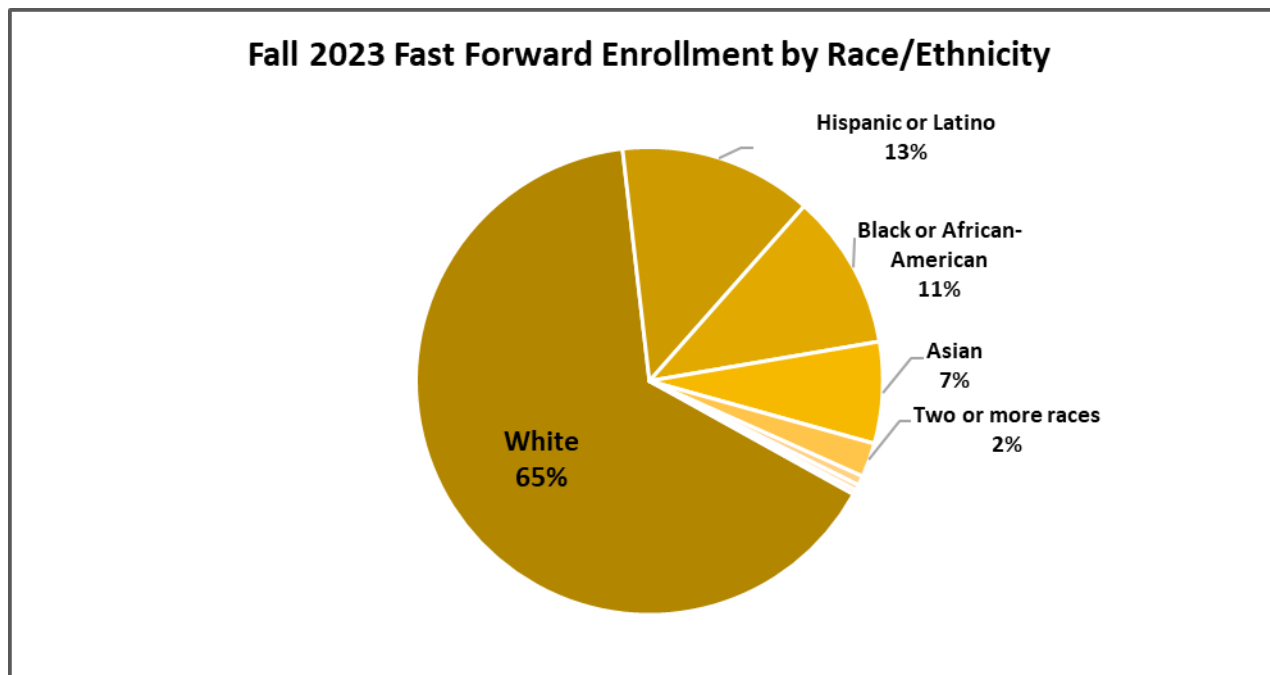
