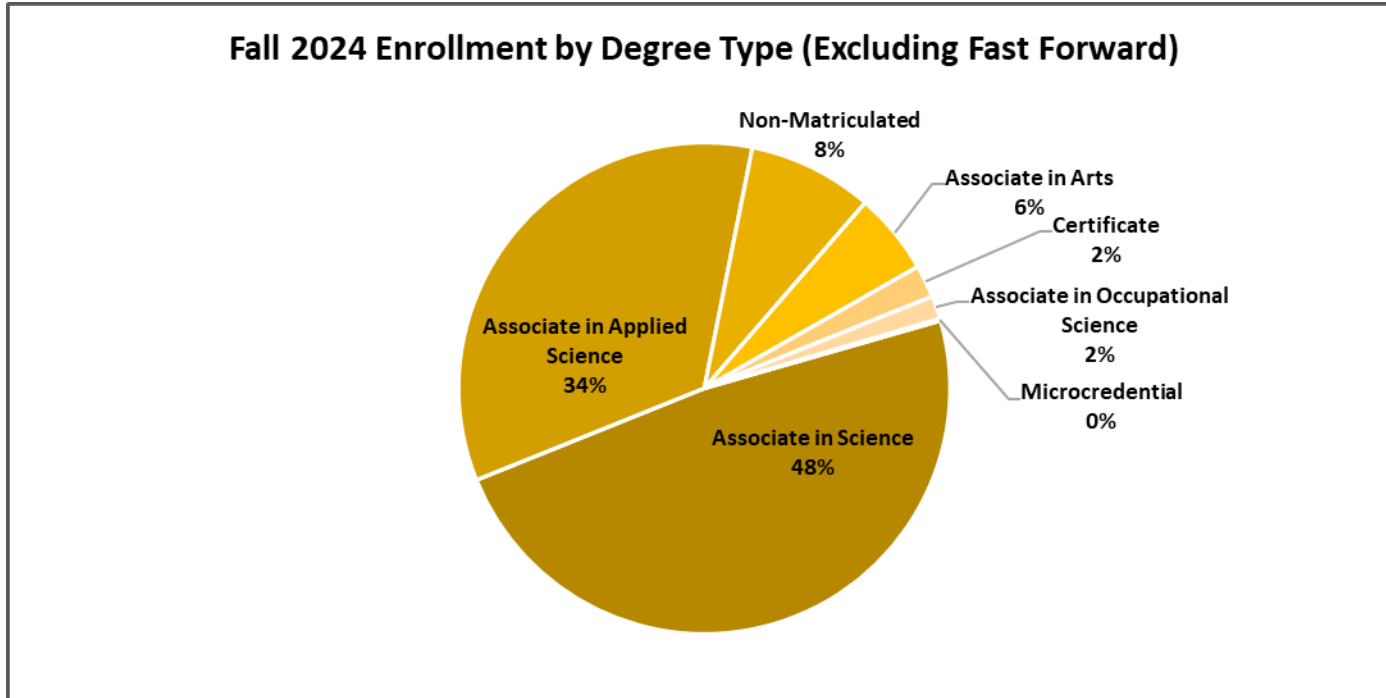

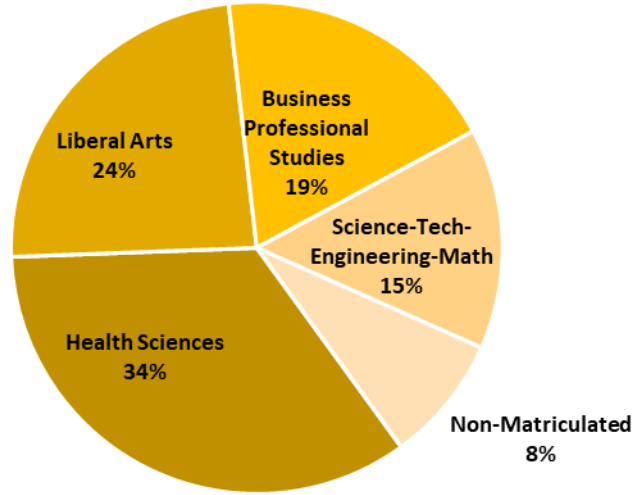
Fall 2024 Enrollment by Degree Type

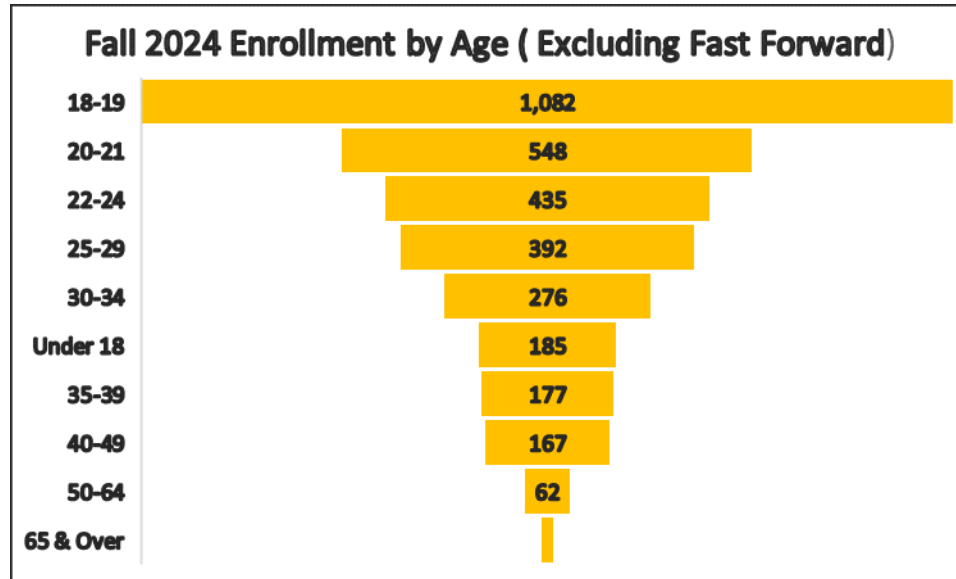
Fall 2024 Enrollment by Academic Division

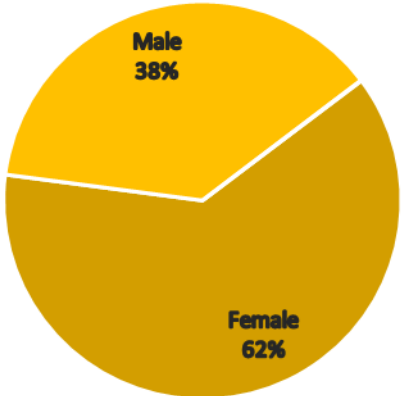
Fall 2024 Enrollment by Age

Fall 2024 Enrollment by Gender

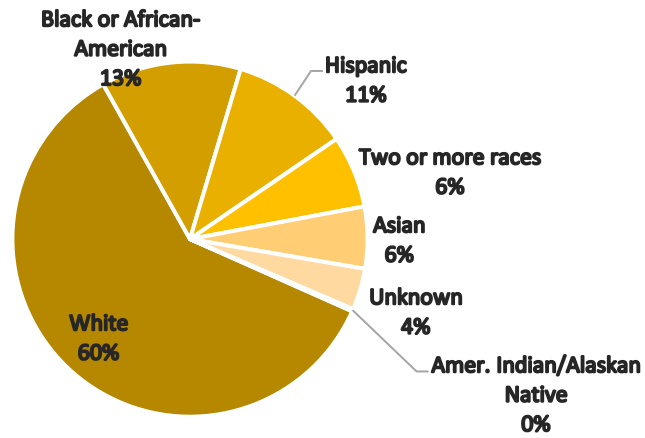
Fall 2024 Enrollment by Gender (Excluding Fast Forward)

Fall 2024 Enrollment by Race/Ethnicity

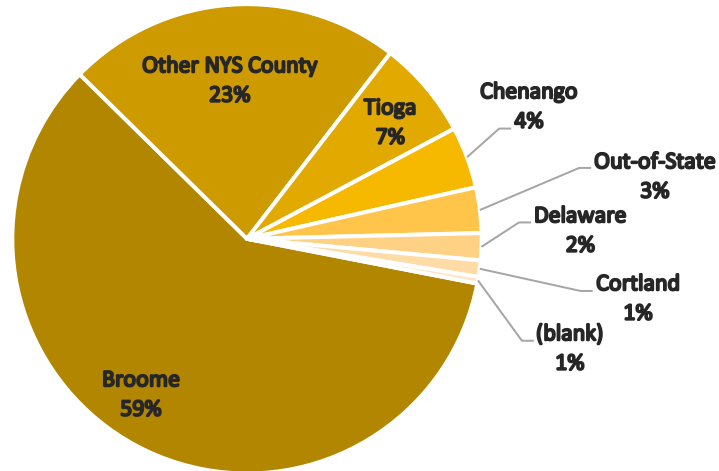

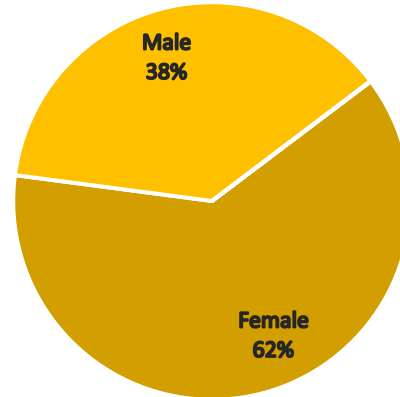
Fall 2024 Enrollment by Residency (Excluding Fast Forward)

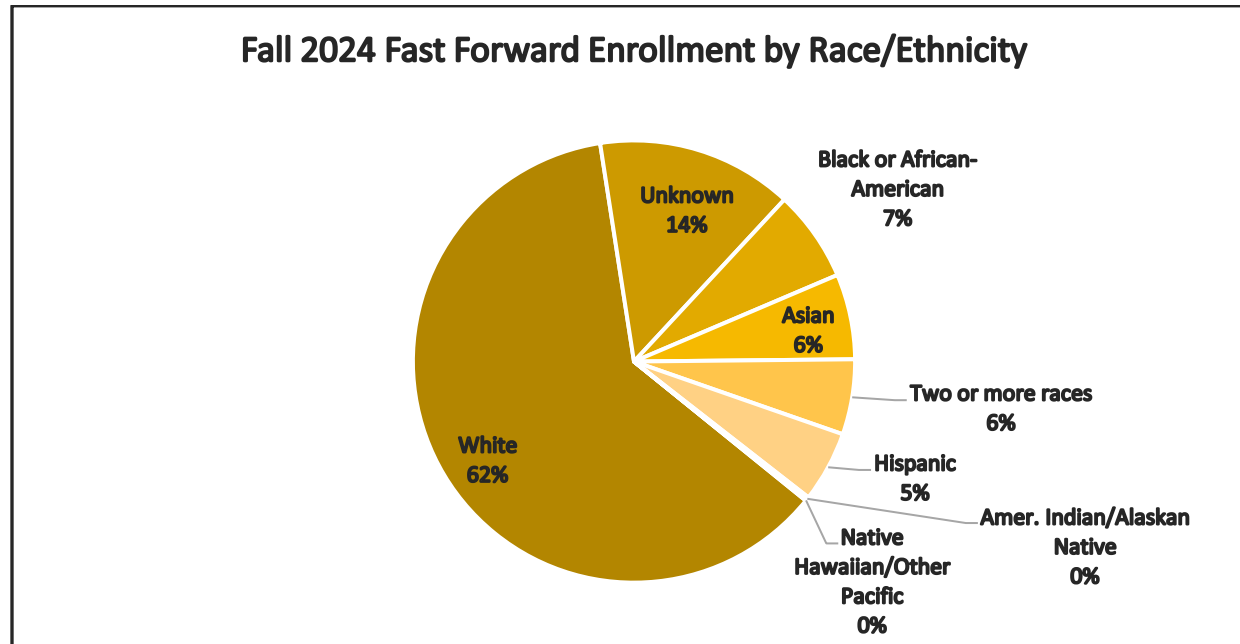
Fall 2024 Fast Forward Enrollment by Gender
