# SUNY BROOME

As part of its ongoing efforts to monitor the success of SUNY Broome Community College's programs, the Office of Institutional Effectiveness conducts an annual survey of graduates to inquire about whether they have found employment and/or have plans to continue their education.

While all graduates are surveyed about finding employment, the College is particularly interested in graduating students from AAS, AOS, and certificate programs, which are designed to prepare students for immediate employment upon graduation. The Transfer Report published by the College provides data related to students who have transferred to other institutions upon graduation and provides an assessment of the preparation of transfer programs (AA and AS programs).

Students graduating from the College in the 2023-2024 year were asked to complete a short survey, which was sent to them via email prior to and after graduation on four separate occasions. A total of 733 students graduated from SUNY Broome in 2023-2024, who collectively earned 762 awards. A total of 201 students responded to the survey, resulting in a response rate of 27.4%. Students were informed the survey was voluntary and that their answers would be kept confidential, with responses reported in summary form. Students were asked to indicate if they had found employment, were seeking employment, or not seeking employment. The majority (73%) of students who responded to the survey had found some level of employment post-graduation. Thirty-nine percent (39%) of respondents reported they had found full-time employment, 32% had found part-time employment, 11% were currently seeking employment, and 14% reported they were not currently seeking employment. 42% of students reported the employment obtained was related to their major. In addition, students were asked if they have enrolled or planned to continue their education in the near future. The majority (74%) of students responding to the survey indicated they were enrolled or planned to continue their education post SUNY Broome.

Graduates were also asked if they had participated in an internship/externship/clinical at the College, and if so, did the experience help prepare them for employment. Of students responding to the survey, 30% reported they had participated in such an experience, with 98% of these students responding that it helped prepare them for employment.

To assess student satisfaction with their academic and overall experience at SUNY Broome, students were also asked to rate their level of satisfaction from Very Satisfied to Very Dissatisfied. The majority of students reported they were Satisfied to Very Satisfied with both their academic and overall experience at the College. Sixty-six percent (66%) reported satisfaction with their academic experience, while 67% reported satisfaction with their overall experience at SUNY Broome.
