
Meet the Tutors




David Bremer

Please stop by and we can make sense of Maslow, Kübler-Ross and anything in between. I want to help!




Abigale Clark

I look forward to working with you and lending any additional support needed. Happy Spring semester!




Christian Dury

I graduated from SUNY Oswego with my Master's in Business Administration in 2020, and looking to further my education in the physical therapy field!


In my spare time, I enjoy teaching dance, spending time with my 1 and a half year old pup, Finley, and taking on new adventures!

Hodaya Katz




Outside of school I enjoying hitting the shooting range, photography, building my garden and Hawaiian shirts. Safety is Everything.

My hobbies are running and video games






Grace Oddo




I am happy to help you with all History and Math courses, and I look forward to seeing you!




Nephtalie Tessier
