## Campus Safety and Security Committee

## I Presidential Charge and Reporting Structure

The committee shall review current campus safety and security policies and procedures and make recommendations for their improvement. It shall specifically review current policies and procedures for:
$>$ identifying and addressing safety and health hazards
> emergency response
$>$ educating the campus community, including security personnel and those persons who advise or supervise students, about sexual assault
$>$ educating the campus community about personal safety and crime prevention;
$>$ reporting sexual assaults and dealing with victims during investigations;
$>$ referring complaints to appropriate authorities;
$>$ counseling victims; and
$>$ responding to inquiries from concerned persons.

The committee shall report, in writing, to the President on its findings and recommendations at least once each academic year, and such report shall be available upon request

## II Committee Membership and Selection Process

Committee appointments will be made annually by the President. Members will be selected from the current students, faculty and staff at the onset of the Fall Semester, but no later than the $30^{\text {th }}$ of September. The committee shall consist of at least six members, at least three of whom shall be female;
$>$ two members shall be appointed from a list of students provided by the Student Assembly that contains at least four names.
$>$ two members shall be appointed from a list of faculty members provided by College Council that contains at least four names.
$>$ two members shall be selected by the President.
