Preface

The program articulation agreement outlined hereafter are entered in good faith by both colleges. University of Limerick and SUNY Broome Community College undertake to co-operate to ensure suitably qualified students have access to Bachelor Degree opportunities

Additionally, it should be noted that:

All program articulation agreements are subject to review on a periodic basis by either institution or to a review, sought by both institutions and the outcome of such reviews will result in the review of the appropriate articulation agreement where necessary. Should either party desire to terminate this agreement, notification shall be given to the other party in writing not less than six (6) months prior to the proposed date of termination.

- Fulfilling the requirements of a program articulation agreement does not constitute a placement offer on that program. Interested students must submit an application and official college transcripts.
- All applicants must provide documentary evidence of having successfully achieved the specific requirements of a particular articulation agreement.
- Merits based scholarships are available to transfer students.
- The existence of a program description in any promotional material from University of Limerick does not constitute a legal undertaking that that program will be available the following academic year.
- All program articulation agreements are effective from the date indicated on the individual agreements and will remain effective for the period of the Memorandum of Understanding unless terminated as a result of a review described above.

UL Programme: Bachelor of Arts in Performing Arts

SUNY Broome Programme: Associates in Science in Music: Performance & Education or Sound Engineering or Music Therapy

Recommended Point of Entry:

SUNY Broome Community College graduates with an Associates in Science in Music: Performance & Education or Sound Engineering or Music Therapy are eligible to enter Year 2 of the Bachelor of Arts in Performing Arts at the University of Limerick.

Grade Requirements:

To be eligible for consideration for entry to this University of Limerick program, SUNY Broome graduates will have achieved a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.00 at Diploma level. This entry requirement is subject to periodic review.

Additional/Alignment Study Requirements:

Students will complete an audition as part of the admissions process (excludes Music: Sound Engineering students). Auditions will be conducted on SUNY Broome Community College's campus by University of Limerick's Music Department.


