PARTNERS IN EXCELLENCE ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

SUNY DELHI AND SUNY BROOME COMMUNITY COLLEGE

Effective Date Fall 2022

Purpose of Agreement:

The purpose of this agreement is to outline the Partners in Excellence articulation agreement between SUNY Delhi and Broome Community College. SUNY Delhi agrees to offer guaranteed admissions into the RN to BSN Baccalaureate Program, delivered online to students who complete Broome Community College's Associate Degree in Nursing program with the minimum requirements outlined below.

Applications for admissions will be reviewed and decisions will be granted during a student's last semester of study at Broome Community College.

Students are eligible to enter the SUNY Delhi RN to BSN Baccalaureate Program prior to passing their NCLEX.

Admissions Requirements:

- 1. Graduation from Broome Community College Associate Degree in Nursing program
- 2. Cumulative GPA of 2.6 or higher upon degree completion
- 3. Associate Degree in Nursing coursework with a C+ or higher
- 4. Liberal arts and science courses with a C or higher, including Anatomy and Physiology I & II, Microbiology, English, and Psychology. Statistics is recommended.

In order to qualify, students must:

- 1. Complete the online SUNY Transfer Application
- 2. Complete SUNY Delhi's electronic Supplemental Information form
- 3. Request Official College Transcripts from ALL colleges attended, to be sent to SUNY Delhi, Office of Admissions

SUNY Delhi agrees to the following:

- 1.) SUNY Delhi agrees to accept 64 credits from Broome Community Colleges Associate Degree in Nursing towards SUNY Delhi's online RN to BSN program.
- 2.) Broome Community College students will be evaluated on an individual basis for additional transfer credit obtained outside of their associate's degree in Nursing. Students can transfer up to 91 total credits. A total of 122 credits is required to satisfy Baccalaureate degree requirements.
- 3.) Upon acceptance, students must complete a minimum of 33 credits of upper-division major nursing coursework required to graduate from the SUNY Delhi RN to BSN program.
- 4.) SUNY Delhi will have a SON representative provide pre-advisement sessions with students interested in transferring during their first year of study. This representative will provide information on the RN to BSN program and curriculum including pre-advisement of suggested electives.
- 5.) SUNY Delhi will have a SON representative and/or an advisor meet with students in their last year of study to review their academics and SUNY Delhi RN to BSN program plan for completing their Baccalaureate degree requirements.

Broome Community College agrees to the following:

Broome Community College will assist in the coordination and preparation of onsite information and/or advisement sessions involving SUNY Delhi.

Terms of this agreement:

The initial term of this agreement shall be four years from the date of the signature, with three (3) automatic renewals of two years each.

The agreement may be amended or renewed by mutual agreement and will be formalized via revision of this agreement.

Broome Community College and SUNY Delhi and agree to communicate program changes in a timely manner to avoid disruption of student progress toward degree completion.

Should either party desire to amend or terminate this agreement, the request for notification shall be given to the other party in writing no less than six (6) months prior to the proposed date of termination.
