I. General Articulation Requirements

- 1) **Purpose:** SUNY Broome Community College (BCC) and Canisius College (CC) are entering into this agreement to facilitate the opportunities for students who wish to transfer from BCC to CC. This agreement specifies the conditions and requirements necessary for students who graduate with an Associate in Science (A.S.) degree in Sport Studies from BCC to transfer to CC with advanced standing in the Bachelor of Science (B.S.) Health and Wellness, Physical Education/Health, Physical Education Sport Pedagogy and Sports and Exercise Health Care majors.
- 2) **Changes:** Neither party may change the agreement unilaterally. Proposed changes in policies or curricula by either party must be communicated in writing to the other party and agreed upon in consultation with relevant officials of each institution. Any changes agreed upon must be signed, dated, and attached to this agreement.
- 3) **Notice of Cancellation:** Either party may independently cancel this agreement by notifying the other party no less than one year before the intended date of cancellation.
- 4) **Period:** This agreement is in effect for a period of five years from the date of signatures. This agreement must be reviewed every five years by an exchange of correspondence between the chief academic of each institution. This agreement will remain in place until terminated.
